Call to Come Together (20 minutes)

- There are dozens of Corvallis groups working on climate change. What can we do together that we can't do separately?
- If we were to establish a Call to Action Network, what would it look like? What would it do? How often would it do it?

Call to Dream (20 minutes)

- Imagine we are meeting ten years from now in 2024. What are we celebrating? What climate goals have we accomplished as a city?
- If we were to compete for the Georgetown University prize, what would we do to make Corvallis stand out as a national leader? (Follow up questions: What is the most innovative, boundary-pushing, game-changing residential/municipal energy project or idea you have ever heard of or thought of? What have you always wanted to change about the way we use fossil fuels in Corvallis? What have other communities done that we could expand on here?)

Call to Action (20 minutes)

- How can we publicly demonstrate 1) our community's deep concern about climate change and 2) our steadfast commitment to immediately reducing greenhouse gas emissions?
- As our first direct action, we are going to do xxx on xxx day. How can we prepare for this action so it sets the stage for many more actions in the future?
