

Now Hiring: – Energy Efficiency Installer

Position Description: The Energy Efficiency Installer will install energy-efficient light bulbs and low-flow faucet/bath aerators in Corvallis homes for the Energy Conservation program, Direct Install, at no cost to the residents. The installer will also collaborate with Corvallis Environmental Center staff to promote the Direct Install program, to schedule installation appointments, and to complete programmatic paperwork.

Our mission is to educate, engage, and inspire people to create a healthy, sustainable community. Responsibilities

- Participate in training and weekly meetings.
- Travel to resident's homes and install light bulbs, faucet aerators, and low-flow showerheads.
- Promote the Energy Conservation program at community events.
- Accurately complete and submit paperwork for each installation in a timely manner
- Maintain an online calendar of your appointments.
- Maintain an accurate record of your inventory.
- Work flexible hours depending on when residents are available for appointments. Some evening and weekend hours will be required.

Requirements

- Have a strong desire to excel and a positive attitude
- Be punctual, professional, dependable, and energetic
- Have reliable transportation. We encourage installers to travel by bike whenever possible. If you drive your car, we will provide a mileage reimbursement for traveling to resident's homes.
- Enjoy working independently and with a wide range of people
- Successfully complete a background check

Work Environment: This position requires frequent travel to resident's homes in your own vehicle or on your bike. The installer must be able to carry supplies into people's houses and use tools to install energy-saving equipment.

Compensation: \$12 per hour plus mileage reimbursement

Hours: 4-10 hours per week depending on how many appointments are scheduled.
