Celebrate Daylight Savings with Free Light Bulbs

Before you turn your clocks back on November 3rd, we'd like to help you brighten up the darkest time of the year with free energy-saving light bulbs. If you are a Pacific Power or Northwest Natural customer, one of our Energize Corvallis volunteers can install up to 10 compact fluorescent light bulbs (CFL), 3 low-flow faucet aerators, and 2 low-flow showerheads at your house. We can even install hard-to-find CFLs like floodlights, 3-way lamps, and candelabras. That adds up to about \$80 worth of free energy-saving goodies. Plus you can **expect an annual savings of up to \$185 in homes with electric heat and up to \$125 in homes with gas heat!**

Neighborhood Sustainability Stewards: Class Starts October 7

OSU Extension's innovative Neighborhood Sustainability Stewards volunteer program engages the local community in climate change actions on a household level. Volunteers attend a 10-session course on climate change and sustainable living topics. Then provide 30 hours of volunteer payback in the community.

The Stewards' goals are to engage the general public in a climate change conversation, to give the public tools to lower CO₂ emissions on a household level, and to give them skills to live sustainably in a changing world.
